**IMPORTANT:**

**SETUP & BUILDING ENTRY:**

*Friday:* Building opens at **4:00 PM** for **SETUP ONLY!** **NO DOGS ALLOWED INSIDE UNTIL 5:00pm!!!**

*Saturday & Sunday:* Building opens at **7:00 AM**

**MEASURING:** Dogs that do not have their permanent height card or valid temporary height form must be measured by the judge of record, VMO, or AKC Field Representative before their first run. You do not have to arrive at the beginning of the day if you need a measure, but please arrive early to provide ample time for measurement before your first run. **Janet Gauntt is a VMO and will be at this trial on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.**

**CHECK-IN, RUN-ORDER:** We will be using the **AGILITY GATE App** to check in for runs to keep the space around the ring less cramped, the **competitor code** for access to the trial is: **0606**. If you do not have a mobile device or iPad to check-in, please see the gate steward. The app is available for download on both iOS and Android devices (the background color of the app you need is purple and references it's for "online gating for dog agility").

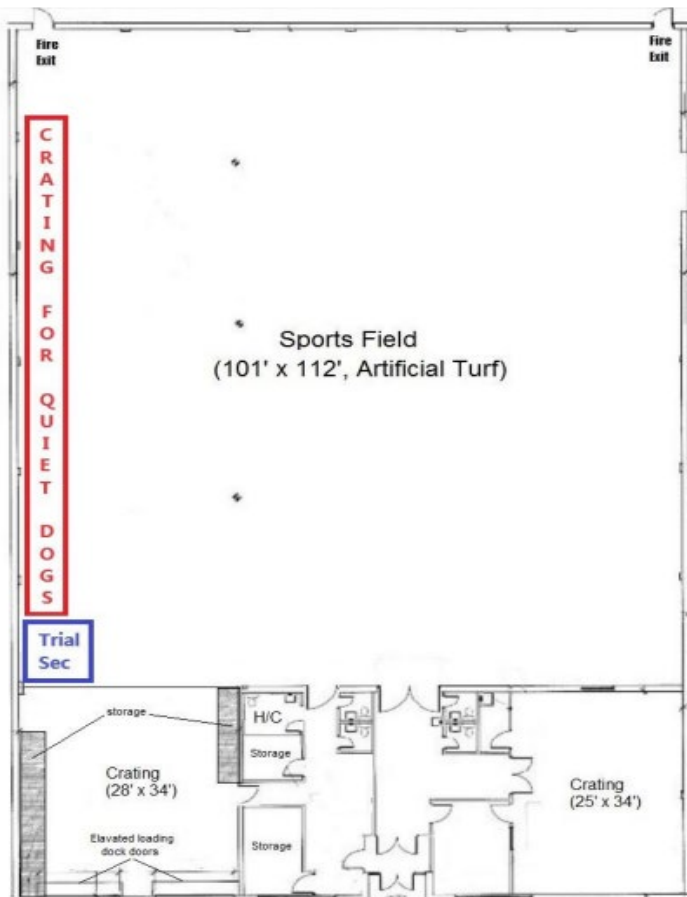
**COURSE MAPS:** Course maps will be posted at the bottom of our event home page which can be found at [EventsAtOriole.Club](https://EventsAtOriole.Club) approximately 1 hour prior to the first dog on the line each day. AKC is no longer allowing course maps to be provided the evening before the trial. Additionally, maps will be available on the Agility Gate app (**competitor code: 0606**). Paper course maps will also be posted on-site, so please come prepared to take a photo of the map for personal use. Copies of course maps will not be provided.

**SCHEDULE & TRIAL INFO:** An estimated schedule and other trial information are posted at the bottom of the home screen at the site below. The start times listed are provided only as a guesstimate, please provide yourself with ample time to arrive before your runs, particularly if you are arriving later in the day as we could be running ahead or behind the estimated schedule.

**CRATING:** Waterproof tarps must be placed underneath all crates and ex-pens. Please see the diagram below that shows available crating space indoors. Space is extremely limited so please be courteous to your neighbors and share as much space as possible. **Saving space for those not on site will not be allowed. Unoccupied tarps will be removed at 10am on Saturday.** Crates have priority, but ex-pens are allowed if they contain 3 or more dogs. If there is insufficient space, you may be asked to remove chairs from the crating areas. Since space is limited, unentered dogs may be asked to leave. You may leave belongings overnight on Friday and Saturday, but no dogs may be left overnight. Please note, ODTG will not be held liable for lost items.

**IMPORTANT** - Dogs crated next to the sports field **must be quiet**. Please be courteous to exhibitors running their dogs in the sports field and be mindful when getting your dog(s) in/out of your crates.



**PARKING:** There is ample parking on-site. Note that this is a business park which has parking spots reserved to specific businesses during the workweek. However, these painted reserved spots do not apply on the weekend and can be used for the trial. Please park only in marked spaces and do not block any loading dock areas. Please do not park in spaces which have temporary signs indicating they are allocated to a particular purpose (example: judge parking, committee parking, RV parking, etc.). If you will not be crating out of your car, please leave the spaces closest to the building for those that will be doing so. You can of course temporarily park closer to the building entrance for unloading/loading.

**RV'ERS:** Limited overnight and daytime RV parking is available at the trial site by pre-arrangement only. No electric or hookup available. Contact Lorinda McKisson for details at [lmckisson@gmail.com](mailto:lmckisson@gmail.com). Day parking is allowed, just be considerate where you park. If you would like a level space marked off for you, please contact trial chair Lorinda McKisson prior to Friday 06/06 to make arrangements.

**POTTY AREA:** Dogs may not be pottied on or next to buildings or dumpsters. Please see the designated **green** grassy potty areas in the diagram below. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor using areas designated as no potty zone or failing to pick up after their dogs will be EXCUSED without refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor is in violation of this requirement.



Remember to pick up anything left  
behind (even if it isn't from your dog).

**BUILDING TEMPERATURE:** The thermostat will be set to the comfort of our dogs. We suggest dressing in layers and/or bringing a jacket.

**LEASHES:** You may run with your leash in your pocket if it fits fully in your pocket, or wear it while running the course, but cannot not drop it!

**FOOD:** No food vendor is available on-site, but there are several fast-food restaurants within a five-minute drive of Oriole.

**VOLUNTEER SIGN UP:** This is a one ring trial and we will have a worker signup board at the trial. Thank you in advance for volunteering - no trial can run smoothly without volunteer help! We offer volunteer hospitality, coupons for each class worked, and a worker raffle where could win gift cards or vouchers for future trials!

**SPECIAL RULES FOR THE SPORTS FIELD:** (1) Food, gum, and drinks *which would leave a stain or residue* may not be consumed anywhere on the sports field. (2) If you use treats before/after the run, only non-crumblly, non-staining treats may be used on the field. The non-turfed hallway just a few feet away should be used for anything else. (3) As is the normal practice with artificial turf facilities, there is a \$10 cleaning charge to be paid if your dog has an accident anywhere on the sports field.

**IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER:** Please use your best judgement in traveling from your home or hotel and be safe! The business complex where we are located will make every effort to clear the parking lot in case of reasonable snow. We will inform you of any delays or cancellation as soon as possible. Directions from the trial site (4.7 miles, approximately 11 minutes):  
From Azar Ct., turn right onto Knecht Ave. Turn right on to Benson Ave. Turn left on Sulphur Spring Rd. Turn right onto Selford Road. Continue onto S. Rolling Road. Turn right onto Bloomsbury Ave. Turn left onto Mellor Ave. Clinic will be on the left.

**DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL/ODTC:** Oriole is located at 9 Azar Court, Halethorpe, MD, 21227.

**Coming North on I-95 from South of Baltimore:** Directly after crossing I-695 take exit 50A-B to merge onto S Caton Ave staying to the right (South 50A). Merge onto S Caton Ave and in 0.2 mile turn right onto Joh Ave. In 0.7 miles turn left onto Benson Ave. Take the 1st left onto Knecht Ave into Benson Business Center in 0.5 miles. Azar Ct and the Oriole building is immediately on your left.

**Coming South on I-95 From Baltimore:** Take exit 50A-50B for Caton Ave. In 0.5 miles, keep right at the fork to continue on Exit 50B, follow signs for Caton Avenue N/Wilkins Avenue and merge onto S Caton Ave. In 0.1 miles turn left onto Benson Ave. In 1.1 miles turn left in Benson Business Center (Knecht Ave) Azar Ct and the Oriole building is immediately on your left.
